FAITH

We are a multiracial, multicultural city supporting a diverse range of religions and communities. The two cathedrals – Anglican and Roman Catholic – may dominate the skyline but Greek orthodox, Unitarian and numerous European churches can be found across Liverpool.

The mosque at 8 Brougham Terrace was the first to be established in England and the Al Rahma mosque near the city centre holds up to 1,000 people. Liverpool also has a thriving Jewish community and the Princes Road Synagogue is one of the finest buildings in the city. Nigerian, Somali and Sikh communities are well established, alongside a Hindu temple on Edge Lane and active Buddhist centre in Aigburth.



ARTS AND CULTURE

We have amazing events every year that celebrate our diverse communities and our creative souls. The Liverpool Irish Festival, Liverpool Arab Arts Festival, DaDaFest, Brouhaha and Liverpool Pride to name a few. Light Night Liverpool is an awesome city takeover offering breathtaking light shows, art installations and street performances, with late-night opening of our museums and galleries. World-renowned classic and contemporary art collections find their homes at the Walker Art Gallery, Tate Liverpool, Open Eye Gallery, FACT, Bluecoat and the Liverpool Biennial.



GREEN SPACES

Parks and waterfront walks in Liverpool are firm favourites. Sefton Park, Festival Gardens, Otterspool Promenade, Princes Park, Calderstones Park and Greenbank offer perfect outdoor space all within easy reach of the city centre. In addition, there are two city centre bus stations, taxis are cheap and plentiful, and, if you need to go over the river, you can always take a ferry 'cross the Mersey.

It has been really helpful to have access to international advice, particularly when handling visa-related issues and concerns about future employment. I submitted my visa application with their complete support.

I was really drawn to LJMU because they offered £3,000 international scholarships annually to self-funded students. This helped ease the financial burden and allowed me to fully engage in university life.

Being surrounded by so many international students fosters a sense of community and support. It is reassuring to know that there are people out there going through similar struggles. This connection is further strengthened by the International Society which brings us all together for fun get-togethers, regardless of nationality.

Given that my parents work in the medical field, pursuing a career in pharmacy felt like the natural choice. I decided to gain international experience by traveling to the UK, as I was aware of the advanced pharmacy practices here.. I chose Liverpool because of its diversity and learned about LJMU's patient-centered, programme. The placements and workshops I have participated in the course have given me priceless practical experience to further develop my pharmaceutical skills.



HOW TO APPLY

APPLY

We recommend submitting your application as early as you can to allow time for application and visa processing. Furthermore, some of our programmes are increasingly popular and applications will close for these throughout the academic year.

Undergraduate students can apply via the UCAS application system at www.ucas.com. This is a secure online system, and is suitable if you have regular access to the internet.

Postgraduate students can apply directly to the University for most courses. Use our online search tool to select the course you are interested in and then choose the option to 'Apply Direct'.

Both undergraduate and postgraduate students can apply through one of our international education partners. RECEIVE AND ACCEPT YOUR OFFER

If you applied via UCAS

You can log on to UCAS Track to see the progress of your application. Once we have made a decision on your application we will update UCAS and you will be able to view and accept your offer online.

If you applied via our education advisers or partners

Your adviser will contact you to update you about the status of your offer and can contact us directly to accept the offer on your behalf. If you have any questions about the status of your offer, please contact your chosen education adviser directly.

If you applied directly

You can log in to your account on our website to track your offer status. Once we have made a decision on your application, we will send you an offer letter to the email address you have provided. To accept your offer and secure your place with LJMU, you will need to click the 'green' accept button in this offer letter.

HOW MUCH DO I NEED TO PAY TO ENROL?

International students must pay an initial deposit of £5,000 plus the first instalment which is due before enrolment. A breakdown of instalments depending on the amount of scholarship received is detailed below.

DOES LJMU OFFER A PAYMENT PLAN?

Students have the option to pay their fees in full or in three equal instalments minus any internal scholarships. The first instalment is due before enrolment. For September 2025 students, the second instalment must be paid by 15 January 2026 and the third by 15 April 2026.

For January 2026 students, the second instalment must be paid by 15 May 2026 and the second instalment by 15 August 2026.

UNCONDITIONAL OFFER

An unconditional offer means that you have met all of our entry requirements.

DEPOSIT

Unless exempt, (see exemptions online) international students will need to pay a minimum deposit of £5,000 to secure their place at the University. This deposit will enable the release of the Confirmation of Acceptance of Studies (CAS), which you will need to apply for your student visa.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

In the last few years, the University has adapted its terms of compliance in relation to English language requirements from international students. For the most up to date information on the types of qualifications we will accept, please refer to our website.



- A very good level of English language competence is required to follow lectures, carry out background reading and research, write essays and dissertations at the University.
- Applicants must hold an internationally recognised English language qualification (such as IELTS and Pearson). Please check our website for acceptable exam boards.
- The minimum scores required by the University are listed below in accordance with UKVI regulations, although specific course requirements may differ:
- International Foundation Year: 4.5 IELTS* or equivalent (min 4.0 in writing)
- Undergraduate: 6.0 IELTS or equivalent (min 5.5 in each skill)
- Postgraduate: 6.0 - 7.0 IELTS or equivalent (min 5.5 in each skill)

*IMPORTANT NOTE:

The English language entry requirements stated are for information regarding entry to the course. If you require a UK visa to study, depending on the type of visa you need, the English language requirements and valid English tests to satisfy the UK visa criteria may differ.




